

2021 OHTSL Board Elections

OHTSL Community Reps,

There will be three OHTSL board positions up for election year.

Greg Byerly and Bill Bryan are both planning to rerun. Lori Pickering has decided to not seek another term on the board.

Here is some information about being a director from the OHTSL Code of Regulations document.

1. **Duties.** Directors are responsible for attending regular and special meetings of the Board (“Board Meeting(s)”) and Member Meetings. Directors are to be active participants in the activities of the Corporation in accordance with the policies set by the Board.
2. **Term.** Each Director’s term is two (2) years with approximately one-half (1/2) of the seats opening each year. Terms end on the same day as each year’s Annual Member Meeting, with the new term beginning on the next day
3. **Officer Membership.** Officers may belong to OHTSL member clubs, however, it is not a requirement that Officers elected or appointed to the Board are also members of affiliated clubs.
4. **Regular Meeting.** During each calendar year, there shall be no less than four (4) regular Board Meetings (“Regular Board Meetings”), with a minimum of one (1) Regular Board Meeting per quarter. The Board shall determine the date, time, and place any such meeting and notice thereof given to Directors thereof. Such meetings are open to any observers, but may be closed by a majority vote of the Board.
5. **Special Meeting.** Any two (2) Directors or the President may call a special Board Meeting (“Special Board Meeting”) by giving notice thereof to the Directors. Such notice shall be sent no less than twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting time.
